<u>FAQ</u>

What classes are required for company?

-For the 2025/2026 season full time company members will be required to take progressions and ballet, as well as the <u>junior/teen company</u> class on Tuesday nights (company prep in the fall and company class in the spring). Part time company members must take either progressions or ballet as well as the Tuesday company class. We require one convention (OKLA) that is held in OKC in October for full time company members. Part time members are encouraged, but not required.

Summer requirements:

Required for full time, but highly recommended for all.
One summer progressions intensive or private equivalent (2 hours of private lessons with Miss Riley or Mrs. Ariel).

Where and when are competitions?

-We compete in 2 group competitions and 2 additional, optional solo/duo/trio competitions. All competitions are in the OKC metro in March, April, and May on weekends.

FAQ

What is the difference between part time and full time company?

-Part time company dancers participate in one all company competition dance. In the fall they will attend every week for company prep. In the spring they will attend every other week to work on routines.

-Full time company members will participate in one all company dance as well as 1-2 other group dances. These group dances will vary in style and number of dancers. Full time dancers are required to attend all company prep and company classes in the spring.

How much does company cost?

- -Registration fee: \$100
- -Company prep class (Sept-Dec): \$50/month
- -Part-time company (Jan-May) \$50/month OR
- -Full time company (Jan-May) \$100/month
- -OKLA dance convention: ~\$125
- -Competition Registration Fees (General: Group ~\$55.00, Solo ~\$125.00, Duo/Trio ~\$85.00)

-This year we will be teaching choreography the weekend of October 25th -26th.



Additional Info

Attendance Policy: Each dancer will be allowed 3 spring company class absences. After 3rd absence the dancer will be required to schedule a 30 minute private lesson with a coach. Private lessons for company are \$25/30 min.

Solos/Duos/Trios: Solos/Duos/Trios are considered extra dances and are up to the choice of the parents. You can contact a coach that you would like to choreograph and they will schedule a time and discuss cost/payment.

Competition Weekends

Competition weekends are an exciting experience and can also feel overwhelming the first few times. Here are some guidelines that can help streamline the experience for parents and dancers:

- -Parents are not permitted backstage or in changing rooms. If you need to drop something off or tell your dancer something that is fine, but there is limited space and dancers will be warming up and preparing as a team. We will take great care of each dancer and make sure no one is left alone!
- -Dance times are typically posted the week of competition, but times can fluctuate. Dances typically compete Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays. Dancers are expected to be at the venue 1.5 hours before their scheduled dance to change, get ready, and warm up.
