Please be prompt to all meeting/rehearsal/call times!

- 11:45** **ALL ARRIVE @ PCHS**
- 12:00-3:00PM** **Tech Run Through – Arrive with hair & makeup done** (show shirt & black leggings)
This rehearsal will have many starts and stops as the Tech Crew set lights, sound and staging. Use this time to familiarize yourself with entrances on and off the stage and where your dressing rooms are. (Youth dancers only in ACT 1 will go directly to class photos after their last dance rehearses and will be released after all their class photos have been taken.)
- 3:00-4:30PM** **Pictures (Recital Group Photo & Class Photos) --We will begin as soon as we wrap Tech!**
- 4:30-5:00PM** **Free/Relax/Rest Time - Touch Up Hair/Makeup** (We will have pizza available)
- 5:00PM** **Junior/Int/Senior Call Time**

ALL DANCERS TO DRESSING ROOMS! Check all costumes are ready to go.
- 5:15PM** **Mandatory Warm Up – ALL Senior/Int/Junior Dancers on stage**
- 5:45PM** **Youth Dancer Call Time – Arrive with Hair & Makeup done**
Go directly to your dressing room. Helpers will be available to get youth dancers into costumes!
- 6:00PM** **Doors Open --- NO SEATS MAY BE SAVED PRIOR TO THIS TIME**
Anything in seats will be removed prior to 6pm
- 6:30PM** **Show Begins**
Dancers are responsible for fully cleaning their dressing rooms before leaving.

IMPORTANT INFO FOR ALL DANCERS

DRESSING ROOMS: Dancers will have designated dressing rooms to go to when they arrive for Tech Rehearsal on Thursday.

YOUNGER DANCERS: Dancers ages 8 and under will have same-gender “helpers” assigned to each class for show day. These helpers will be assigned to each youth class. This will allow parents to watch and enjoy recital without having to worry that their child isn’t being helped with costume changes, hair emergencies, or any nerves that may arrive prior to performance! You will simply drop your child off at their assigned dressing room and go find a seat! Youth dancers will be dismissed to a parent from the dressing room once all their dances have been completed.

COSTUMES: Costumes are your responsibility. Please double check that you have all hair pieces, neck pieces, wings, hats, etc before you leave your dressing room to go onstage. Absolutely NO EATING OR DRINKING IN COSTUMES WITHOUT A TSHIRT OVER IT with the exception of a water bottle!

TIGHTS: ALL DANCERS that are wearing pink or tan tights with their costumes, must wear like new (good condition) tights free of holes! If you need tights, you can purchase them locally at Showbiz Dancewear.

SHOES: Performance dance shoes need to look nice – no holes in the toes, frayed seams, excessive wear, etc. If they are dirty, you need to spot clean them with a mild detergent and let them air dry. This applies to ballet, tap, and jazz shoes. Hip Hop students, please see your teacher for details on shoes to be worn.

HAIR AND MAKEUP

HAIR: All dancers will wear their hair as follows: slicked back, middle part, low bun center. No bangs or wispies! Use a water bottle and gel, plus bobby pins as needed to keep all hair secured. NO wispies or fly-aways! All hair is to be slicked securely back away from the face.

SHORT HAIR OPTION: (Only for girls who cannot make a ponytail with their hair.) Front of hair parted down the middle, slicked back and pulled half up using clips that are the same color as hair. All remaining hair is to be straightened and sprayed.

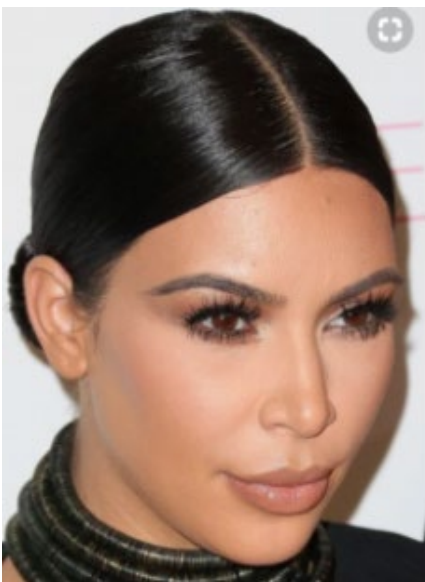
MAKEUP: See the last page for sample photos/how-to.

Makeup will be basic stage makeup. Please refer to the how to in the following page if you have never completed stage makeup.

Youth Dancers – foundation and blush to match the dancers skin tone, Brown/Black mascara and eyeliner, light natural eye shadow and strong red lipstick.

Intermediate & Senior Level Dancers- Foundation and blush to match your skin tone. Neutral eye shadow, black/brown mascara and eyeliner with lashes, and strong red lipstick. Must have false lashes.

IMPORTANT INFO (CONTINUED)

LOBBY: We will be selling cookies, MOVEMENT OKC items, etc prior to the show and during intermission. Tickets will be on sale for those who need to purchase tickets at the door. They are \$15 the day of the show. Tickets can be purchased with cash, or via Cash App & Paypal.

T SHIRTS: We are placing tshirt orders for Cast shirts (all dancers will receive a shirt). Any parents or family members that would like a shirt, the price is \$25. To insure you get the size you like, please send us your size and amounts via email by no later than Sunday the 10th. We will have it ready for pickup at Dress Rehearsal. We will not be selling additional shirts at recital, so make sure to get your pre-order in ASAP!

ACCOUNTS: All accounts **MUST BE** paid in full by the show date. If you believe you have any outstanding charges on your account (including rental fees), you may contact the office to discuss.

CLASSES: May 22 is the last day of regular classes for Season 5, there are no classes during show week.

FLOWERS: It is customary for dancers to receive flowers for a performance. Please note: We ask that if you do give your child or loved one flowers, please wait until after the entire show has ended. Please do not give them flowers during the actual finale/curtain call. We do this so that no dancer feels left out in case flowers were not available for them. Thank you for your cooperation.

STAGE MAKEUP TUTORIAL

INFORMACIÓN IMPORTANTE PARA TODOS LOS BAILARINES (TRADUCCIÓN ESPAÑOLA EN LA PARTE POSTERIOR)



1. Start with a clean face. Pull your hair back to begin.



2. I prefer a non greasy stick foundation. It doesn't streak when you perspire and a light application has good coverage.



3. Blend foundation from center of face to hairline.



4. Apply cheek color over half of apple of cheek and follow cheekbone to hairline. Remember stage lights will wash you out.



5. Use a powder or pencil to define a classic brow shape. Have your brows groomed and shaped prior to show time.



6.. Apply a vibrant red to lips. Please be careful when changing clothes as red lipstick will smear and smudge easily.



7. Pearl white eye color is applied on eye lids, as high lite under brows and under lower lashes to make eyeliner "pop".



8. Matte brown eye shadow is applied to brow bone and outer corner of the eye lid.



9. Apply eyeliner to upper eye lid and leave a "tail" at the outer corner. Next apply to the lower eye lid. Add false eyelashes with the proper glue. Last cover lashes with mascara.
